

They can be seen volunteering on Make a Difference Day, manning the gates and concession stands at athletic events, involved in our annual Auction, and adding their strong support to our Annual Gift-Giving Campaign. Senior DE'AVEON FISHER-PRIMM presented the CHRIS GALLMAN SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD

Chris Gallman was a member of the CHS Class of 1999. In May of 1998, just days after winning the District high jump gold medal at the end of his Junior year and shortly before he was to leave for the State Track Meet, he died very suddenly and tragically of an undiagnosed heart condition. His death left the Catholic High community stunned and heartbroken. 

As a member of the Basketball and Track Teams, in addition to being one of the Football managers, De'Aveon consistently exemplified the qualities for which this award is given. She clearly demonstrated that her primary concern was her team's unity and integrity, and not her own accomplishments. 


