PRINCIPAL

Dear Alumni, Parents, and Friends of Pensacola Catholic High School,

It seems this time of year rolls around more guickly with each passing year the satisfying end to another great year at Catholic High School! We started the 2020-2021 school year a few weeks later than usual due to the impact of COVID-19. As a result, this school year ended two weeks later than usual. However, we are very grateful to have finished the year on a more "normal" note than how we began ten months ago. We are most grateful for the protection and safety experienced by the CHS family throughout this year and pray that the worst of this pandemic is now behind us.

We are so blessed to have an amazing CHS faculty and staff who once again went above and beyond in their roles this year, teaching to our "brick and mortar" students who were on campus, as well as effectively engaging our "eLearning" students who studied via Zoom. It took much time, effort, and creativity to keep both sets of students effectively engaged and to provide



them with the resources they needed in order to be successful. I cannot thank our wonderful faculty enough for their continued dedication to our students and the excellent quality education they provide!

I am also very grateful and proud of how our students responded to the many adjustments required in a "COVID world." Numerous changes to "normal life" were thrust upon them-the loss of enjoyable activities and programs; and new routines were required of them this year - temperatures being taken each morning, the wearing of masks, using of desk shields, walking in one direction to change classes, cleaning desks after each class, etc. It took the cooperation of all to make it through this unusual year so safely and well. While we had to forego some of our annual activities in the Fall and Winter. we were very blessed to be able to have our Junior-Senior Prom and the full gamut of Senior activities without seating limitations this Spring. The resilience and strength of faculty and students helped us to experience the message of Galatians 6: 9, "Let us not grow weary of doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up." We are very proud of our faculty and students and grateful for their dedication and perseverance!

The Class of 2021 did an excellent job of finishing strong. We are especially pleased with the accomplishments of our 139 graduates in the classroom. Ninety-seven percent of the class are pursuing postsecondary education with 88 students, or 63% of the class, earning at least one merit-based scholarship. The class, in total, was offered more than \$16.1 million in merit-based scholarships. Forty-three students or 31% were recognized



as Florida Bright Future Scholars – 22 earning the distinction of being named a Florida Academic Scholar, the highest tier of the Florida Bright Futures Scholarship Program, and an additional 21 students were named Florida Medallion Scholars. Three of our students are planning to join our Armed Forces; we thank them in advance for their service to our country. We could not be prouder of the Class of 2021 and pray for them daily as they bring their Crusader Spirit with them in their new endeavors.

Despite some impact from COVID-19 limitations, our Core Value of Commitment to Service was still strongly demonstrated with 21,067 hours of service to various local agencies and projects amassed by the entire student body. We were also very excited to once again host our annual Make a Difference Day activity in which we participated in over 30 projects across the community. Of course, we could not be successful in all these endeavors without the continued blessing of our many adult volunteers, from both our parent and alumni communities, who help us on various CHS committees/activities. Your service to CHS is so appreciated; we could not accomplish all that we do without you!

Excellence in the classroom was coupled with excellence in the athletic arena. Four of our graduates

were offered athletic scholarships to compete on the next level and as our teams earned six district titles across the wide range of sports in which we compete and both the Golf and Tennis teams competed at the State level.

For the past thirty-two years, the generosity and support of the Catholic High Family in our annual Gift-Giving Campaign has been tremendous, helping us to fulfill our Mission: To develop responsible Christian individuals by providing the finest in Catholic education - Thank you! I am also very grateful for your continued support of our Faith, Family & Tradition Capital Campaign which helped us to realize

the completion of our first phase of construction--the Athletic Complex and the Tolan Family Student Life Center in January, 2021. We look forward to rejuvenating our Campaign in the 2021-22 school year as we strive to realize the additional dreams detailed in our school's Master Growth Plan. Each of these additional projects will enable us to continue our Commitment to Excellence into the future. We are also deeply grateful to the wonderful team of staff and parent volunteers who made our annual Starry, Starry Knight Auction such a wonderful success, especially given the challenge of limitations posed by the pandemic. Through both the gifts given by our generous sponsors and the merchandise sales, our Auction committees helped us to raise over \$71,000.

It is so humbling to see all the blessings God has continued to bestow on Catholic High! We thank God for His deep love and for YOU, the loving Catholic High Community!










Change in Net Assets





We are all called by God to be and students alike. Father Mooney an essential part of His Church -- recalls that he first thought about the brothers and sisters of God's the priesthood late in high school kingdom here on Earth. GEOFFREY MOONEY, former ACE Teacher at CHS from 2009-2014. was ordained a priest on April 10 at the Basilica of the Sacred Heart on the campus of the University of Notre Dame. He is a member of the Congregation of the Holy Cross, just as our very own Bishop William Wack. Fr. Mooney is originally from New Albany, IN where he attended Catholic schools from kindergarten through twelfth grade before heading off to Notre Dame where he earned both his B.S. in Mathematics and B.A. in Theology in 2009. He later received his M.Ed. and his M.Div. in 2011 and 2020, respectively. After graduating with his undergraduate degrees, he was sent to CHS as part of the Alliance for Catholic Education (ACE) program through which he taught Math and Religion. He also worked with Eric Nelson on the Cross Country and Track Teams, and was beloved by fellow faculty

didn't seriously discern until his time in the ACE program and the vears he spent at CHS. "I owe a lot to the students, teachers, and staff at CHS for inspiring me in this

PAUL HOTOVY, former ACE Teacher at CHS from 2011-2016, is currently a novice with the Salesians of Don Bosco, Province of St. Philip the Apostle, an international community of consecrated religious, where he is studying to be a priest. Paul grew up in a strong Catholic family in Omaha, NE, and during his high school/college years he always felt like he should go to church and pray but did not always act on that feeling or did not feel any impact from it. After graduating from Notre Dame, he was sent to CHS as part of the ACE program where he taught Math and Social Studies. Geoff Mooney, who you just read about, was assigned as his mentor teacher for his first year of teaching. Paul recalls that his experience at Catholic High, especially with Sister Kierstin and his co-workers, Geoff Mooney and Chris Holcomb, and the overall family-like atmosphere that is cultivated at CHS was very formative in his ultimate decision to pursue the religious life -- "There were many great witnesses to authentic Catholic life there: my principal, local priests, and my coworkers." He was asked to be involved in the student retreats while at Catholic High during which he gave testimonies on prayer and his life as a committed Catholic. He shared that this prompted him to reflect more on his own faith and prayer and eventually led to his understanding "that being Catholic is about a relationship with God and not just a series of tasks to accomplish." In 2016 he made the decision to move back to Omaha and consider the priesthood or religious life. It has taken him some time discerning and meeting the right people that God has sent into his life, but he feels that God has sent him enough signs for him to join the Salesians whose mission is to evangelize and educate young people, especially those who are poor and at risk. will be attending Immaculate Conception Seminary at Seton Hall University while living with a Salesian community in Orange, NJ. We will continue to pray for Paul as he prepares to make his first profession of vows as a Salesian this coming August.

PETER JUTRAS, CHS Class of 2014, will be starting his fourth year in the Pensacola-Tallahassee Diocesan Seminary in August. Before his family moved to Pensacola, Peter

grew up in the Orlando area and remembers "playing" Mass when he was six/seven years old, using crackers for the host and orange juice for the wine. He remembers always wanting to be on the altar to be close to the tabernacle, perhaps his first call to the priesthood. After graduation from CHS Peter attended the University of West Florida and earned a degree in Telecommunications and Film. It was in 2018 after attending

Chris also remembers hearing the whisper of a call when he was "a kid" and even during his time as a Crusader. He

Chris attended Spring Hill College for his undergraduate degrees in Math and Theology and FSU for his graduate degree in film production. He taught Math and Religion classes during his time on the faculty of Catholic High from 2011-2019. He actually taught fellow seminarian Peter Jutras in one of his elective classes. Chris also attended a Discernment Retreat in 2019 during which time he made the decision to pursue the priesthood. He is spending the Summer of 2021 in the "summer house" in Tallahassee, residing with other seminarians. We always enjoy his visits to CHS during his

breaks to see his family, including his sister, Rebecca Carter ('92), CHS Campus Minister and Religion Teacher, and one of Chris' teachers when he was a CHS student.

ZAC ARNOLD, CHS Class of 1997. will be starting his first year at the St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary for the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee in August. He will report one day before his fortysecond birthday. After graduating from CHS, Zac attended what was then Pensacola Junior College and UWF earning an undergraduate degree in History. He later earned a M.A. in Military History and Political Science. After earning his Military History degree, Zac spent six years working for Central Texas

College while never stepping foot in Texas. He was assigned to U.S. Navy ships where he traveled the world teaching Sailors and Marines courses in history and government. More recently, Zac has taught Middle School in the Pensacola area. Zac grew up in a practicing Catholic family and remembers being active in his faith and church life. During class one day in his senior year at Catholic High, he remembers being sent by his Religion teacher, Peggy Soule, along with another classmate, to see the Vocation Director. They did not know the reason for the visit but soon discovered that Ms. Soule had recommended them to consider the call to the

priesthood. He remembers them discussing it for a few minutes and then saying "Thanks" as they left his office. His fellow classmate became a Franciscan Priest, one of the fourteen mentioned at the beginning of this article, and now Zac is beginning his journey in the seminary – "I guess Mrs. Soule was pretty good at recognizing 'the call' even before we were." Zac shared that, throughout his adult life, he has always felt a consistent "tug", and after several discernment retreats, much thought and prayer, decided that it is now time for him to pursue his call. We pray that God will continue to guide Zac as he begins his formation!

It is so heartwarming to know that Pensacola Catholic High School has had a profound impact on these men, deepening their faith, and more specifically their call to be a priest. We would love to know of others that we can pray for by name so if you know of a CHS alum who is already studying or discerning a religious vocation, please let us know. Also, know that we pray for all of our CHS alumni in whatever vocation they have chosen or will choose. Our prayer is that God will always be the center of their lives! †

SENIOR AWARDS

CHRIS GALLMAN SPORTSMANSHIP AWARD



Chris Gallman was a member of the CHS Class of 1999 and a very talented member of both the Basketball and Track Teams. In May of 1998, just days after he won the District high jump gold medal at the end of his Junior year, and shortly before he was to leave for the State Track Meet, he very suddenly and tragically died of an undiagnosed heart condition. His death left the Catholic High community stunned and heartbroken. Chris was a very special person - a very talented athlete, a friend to all, rarely seen without a smile on his face and a kind word for everyone - truly the epitome of kindness and good sportsmanship.

Shortly after his tragic and untimely death, there was a ground swell of desire from all parts of the CHS family - students, teachers, administrators, parents...all, recognizing the unique goodness of Chris Gallman and asking

that CHS establish an award in his honor... to memorialize the goodness he contributed and stood for in his life at Catholic High, his sportsmanship, selflessness, and compassion.


These qualities became the focus and criteria for the bestowal of this award that is given each year at Commencement exercises. With the input of athletes in each of our CHS athletic programs, the entire CHS faculty, and the CHS coaching staff, the selection of the recipient for the Chris Gallman Sportsmanship Award is conducted each year.

The year's recipient of the Chris Gallman Award participated in three varsity sports throughout the year -Cheerleading, Soccer, and Lacrosse. In the award's selection process, she was nominated by each of the three teams on which she participated

as their Senior team member best qualified to receive this award. This is something that has never happened before in the selection process.
