

## The right support at the right time.

The Adaptive Education Program (AEP) at PCHS provides support services for students with an identified learning inhibition. AEP is an essential resource for students with **ADHD**, **OCD**, **ASD**, **Anxiety**, or any other qualifying diagnoses. AEP provides support on three possible levels, based on student need.

- Qualified AEP students (formal documentation required) receive accommodations such as extended time, small group testing on major assessments, and other accommodations identified for the student in their Learning Support Plan.
- In addition to receiving tutorial assistance, AEP students enrolled in the Learning Strategies class also learn study and organizational skills that benefit them in their current curriculum as well as in all future studies.
- Our AEP Director is available to provide guidance to parents in obtaining a formal evaluation for their student if they believe he/she may have an undiagnosed learning inhibition.
