The application consists of:

- 2. High School Certification
- 3. Essay of a minimum of 750 words and a maximum of 1000 words entitled: "What impact did the establishing of the Pensacola Navy Yard in 1826 have on the growth of Northwest Florida?" The essay portion will be juried by a group of Pensacola Heritage Foundation members who will read the essays without regard to the identity of the student. The PHF committee will then make the selection of the winning students based on the committee input. Names of the students will not be on the essay which insures choosing the essay on content alone. Pensacola Heritage Foundation will have rights of publishing submitted essays in newspapers and magazines. Also, Pensacola Heritage Foundation will have the right to use the essays in future publication.

The application must be <u>received</u> by Pensacola Heritage Foundation by Friday, March 21, 2025 (late entries will not be considered). The winning students will be notified on or about April 15, 2025 by the President of Pensacola Heritage Foundation or their representative with a follow up news release.
