The 2023-2024 school year was another great year that built on the legacy that is Pensacola Catholic High School; I am so grateful to all of you for helping to make it a very blessed year!

This year's annual spiritual theme was 'The Bread of Life' inspired by the National Eucharistic Revival through which the Catholic Church in the United States aims to reaffirm the divine invitation to be united once again around the source and summit of our faith, the Eucharist. Throughout the year, our faculty reminded the students of God's unconditional love, which led Jesus to become man and die for us. Christ's sacrifice on the cross and victory over the grave redeem us from our sins -everyone, no matter how grave the sin. We are so proud of the Class of 2024! In the pages that follow, you will find some highlights of their accomplishments and contributions over the past four years. I would like to point out a few - a total of 168 Crusaders graduated with 108 or 64% of them receiving at least one meritbased scholarship totaling \$15.3 million in scholarships. This monetary total includes 57 students or 34% of the class earning Florida Bright Futures scholarships and 17 students earning athletic scholarships to play at the next level. academic excellence attained by our students: 44 additional students were inducted into our National Honor Society; the CHS Math Team once again

Walker Math Tournament and brought home first place overall for the 15th consecutive year; they also competed in the Math Bowl at Northwest Florida State College, placing second in their division and Senior Nate Flores took first overall; our Crubotics/Robotics Team competed in the Ranger and Navigator divisions at the Gulf Coast Regional MATE competition this year during which the Ranger division again qualified to compete at the World Competition in Tennessee this summer for the third consecutive year!

We are also very proud of our nine athletic teams which were recognized in the State for their average unweighted GPAs of 3.2 or higher. Our athletic teams also excelled in the field of play with a total of seven Crusader teams winning District Titles with numerous teams advancing to participate on the regional level. Seven of our teams or individuals from a team also qualified to compete at the State level with two of our athletes earning the 'State Champion' title-Boys' Weightlifting and Girls Tennis. We also won the first-ever 'Bishop's Cup' on the gridiron this past Fall -- it sure is great to be a Crusader!

I am also so grateful to our students and many volunteers who dedicate their time and talent to bring Christ's love to our community. Our student body amassed a yearly total of 30,351 hours of service to various local agencies/organizations through their dedication to our Core Values of Commitment to Service and Selfless Love. Our annual Make a Difference Day event held in September also impacted the community with over 30 different projects led on that day, with more than 420 students and parents volunteering to work! We are so grateful for all those who participated in the various CHS committees and activities that we have all year. You are at the heart of CHS!



The new Tolan Family Student Life Center has been invaluable in helping us with space for meetings as we often find multiple meetings taking place in the SLC and the Brent Media Center at the same time. Let's face it, the needs of Catholic High have definitely changed since this campus first opened in 1958 and our new facilities continue to show their value to our current students. teachers, and families.

We are so thankful for the wonderful team of staff and parent volunteers who made the annual Starry, Starry Knight Auction, our single parentled fundraiser, such a great success again this year. It brought in over \$72,000 through both sponsorships and auction proceeds. We are also so blessed to have the generosity and support of the entire Catholic High Family in our annual Gift-Giving and Capital Campaigns that help us to fulfill our Mission: to develop responsible, Christian individuals by providing the finest in Catholic education --- THANK YOU! 
The first recipient of the Chris Gallman Award, Maria Bush, participated in Tennis at CHS. Her goodness of Chris Gallman and coach described her by saying,



BUILDING ON FAITH, FAMILY & TRADITION

The rich history of Pensacola Catholic High School has roots in the Pensacola community that dates back to 1840 when the first Catholic school for any duration is established in the area and it is another 37 years later in 1877 before continuous Catholic education is documented. In 1941, all Catholic secondary education is centralized in Pensacola and Catholic High School is "born". On September 14, 1941, 170 students report for their first day of school to Pensacola Catholic High School which is located at the corner of Garden and Baylen Streets. The timeline below lays out how we evolved from this first location downtown to our current campus today.



to have attended a Catholic high school, a CHS Past-Parent and now a four-year employee of Catholic High, I consider myself extremely blessed to be able to work at CHS and finally get my Catholic school experience! I have had the privilege to work with the wonderful faculty and administrators that Sr. Kierstin has assembled, not only now as an employee, but as a parent volunteer when my students attended. In my current role, I also have the opportunity to work with some AMAZING alumni and current parents. All of these wonderful subgroups of the Catholic High family are a part of what ultimately makes Catholic High the very special place that it is. However, we also need the brick and mortar of the school to support the wonderful family that works and attends here. I want to share my perspective and some information I have learned in the past few years. Catholic education does not exist without the dedication and commitment of the community and parents who must help to make it a reality. All those who came before us had to contribute and invest in the brickand-mortar that makes the Catholic High campus what it is today. We, as the community and parents of today, need to do our part to ensure that CHS continues to adapt to the

As someone who was not fortunate ever-growing needs of our students. We still have additional projects identified in the updated 2023 Master Growth Plan that have not vet been completed and we need the help of all constituent parties in the Crusader Family to help us realize these dreams.

> Did you know that Pensacola Catholic High School does not receive any direct funding from the Diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee? Yes, we have access to low-interest rates when we need to borrow money for a project, but we don't receive any other direct funds. For those of you who are practicing Catholics and have received a Catholic discount on your tuition, did you know that CHS never receives funds from your parish to cover that discount? We have received periodic donations from parishes in the past for special projects, but no direct, budgeted monies related to reducing your tuition. All funding for Pensacola Catholic High School comes from tuition payments (which now includes a state-funded scholarship program), fundraising projects, and contributions from donors, like you, who support our annual fundraisers and/or capital campaigns when they are held. This Annual Report seeks to share the outcome of those fundraisers and campaigns each year.

You may be wondering about the difference between the Annual Gift-Giving Campaign, that is conducted every year, and the Building on Faith, Family & Tradition Capital Campaign. Today, Catholic High's Tuition structure only includes the expenses needed to educate students for the current academic year. It has not contained any financial component toward capital additions or significant improvements to the campus. Our annual budget provides funds only for minor maintenance repairs and periodic replacement of existing assets, and even then, we rely on grants and/or other donations to make these needed enhancements and acquisitions possible.

The Annual Campaign raises funds to cover one-time, expenses and projects that arise during the school year. This helps us keep tuition as affordable as possible. The funds are used to cover expenses in the following areas:

- To enhance salaries/benefits which enables us to attract and retain quality faculty
- To provide educational materials that help us offer quality courses and the technology/ software solutions to support them
- To provide tuition assistance to those who qualify, to help

make our school accessible to all those who wish to attend

 To design and undertake projects that provide maintenance on existing assets or enhancements to facilities, technology, etc.

A Capital Campaign is conducted following a detailed Master Growth Plan that is developed by our School Advisory Committee on a periodic basis. In recent history, Catholic High has had two such capital campaigns.

- 1999, Building on the Legacy of Excellence - To fund projects on the original Master Growth Plan and timeline for completion from between 1999 - 2004
- 2018, Building on Faith, Family & Tradition Phase 1, paused by COVID-19 - \$6M goal of which \$4M was raised to fund projects on our second Master Growth Plan and on the timeline for completion between 2018 - 2024. Naming Opportunities that cover part of our additional projects were also received from donors during this phase but additional funds are needed to undertake and complete these projects and dreams.
- 2023, Building on Faith,

Family & Tradition Phase 2, re-started in Fall, 2023 - New \$6M goal to complete the projects identified in the Updated Master Growth Plan that are detailed on the Catholic High website at pensacolachs.org/ capitalcampaign.




